1 SENATE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, It is estimated that 1,762,450 new cases of cancer 2 3 will be diagnosed in the United States in 2019; and WHEREAS, The lifetime probability of a male or female 4 5 developing cancer is 1 in 3; and 6 WHEREAS, A cancer survivor is defined as anyone who has 7 been diagnosed with cancer, from the time of diagnosis through 8 the balance of his or her life; and 9 WHEREAS, The National Cancer Institute reports that there 10 are 15,500,000 cancer survivors in the United States, and the 11 number of cancer survivors is expected to increase to 12 20,300,000 by 2026; and 13 WHEREAS, Cancer treatments can have severe, prolonged, or permanent side effects, both physical and psychological; and 14 WHEREAS, Men, women, and children have been diagnosed with 15 16 and battled cancer; and 17 WHEREAS, Cancer Survivor Beauty and Support Day is a purely 18 volunteer event where volunteers from the spa, beauty, and 19 related industries offer their support and provide

- 1 complimentary services to all cancer survivors; and
- 2 WHEREAS, The goal of Cancer Survivor Beauty and Support Day
- 3 is to ensure that all survivors feel empowered and included in
- 4 their communities; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Since its inception in 2003, Cancer Survivor
- 6 Beauty and Support Day has expanded to include thousands of
- 7 salons in all 50 States, Canada, and the United Kingdom; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Cancer Survivor Beauty and Support Day is
- 9 recognized by both state and local governments and numerous
- 10 cancer support groups; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Cancer Survivor Beauty and Support Day is the only
- 12 event of its kind, with no solicitation of funds before,
- during, or after the event; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Each year, the first Tuesday in June is recognized
- as National Cancer Survivor Beauty and Support Day; therefore,

- 17 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED FIRST GENERAL
- 18 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare June 4, 2019
- 19 as Cancer Survivor Beauty and Support Day in the State of
- 20 Illinois; and be it further

- 2 men, women, and children cancer survivors, and the positive
- 3 impact support has for both patients and families.
