SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

510 ILCS 70/6.5 new

Amends the Humane Care for Animals Act. Provides that no person may knowingly allow an animal to ingest cannabis, including second-hand smoke, or cannabis-infused products in a way that results in the animal's sickness or death. Provides that a first violation is a Class A misdemeanor, and a second or subsequent violation is a Class 4 felony. Effective immediately.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Humane Care for Animals Act is amended by 5 adding Section 6.5 as follows:

6 (510 ILCS 70/6.5 new)

7 <u>Sec. 6.5. Animal ingestion of cannabis or cannabis-infused</u>
8 <u>product.</u>
9 <u>(a) As used in this Section, "cannabis" and</u>
10 <u>"cannabis-infused product" have the meanings given to those</u>

11 terms in the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act.

12 (b) No person may knowingly allow an animal to ingest 13 cannabis, including second-hand smoke, or cannabis-infused 14 products in a way that results in the animal's sickness or 15 death.

16 (c) A person convicted of violating this Section is guilty 17 of a Class A misdemeanor. A second or subsequent violation is a 18 Class 4 felony.
