The Business Enterprise for Minorities, Women, 4 5 and Persons with Disabilities Act is amended by adding Section 6 81 as follows: 7 (30 ILCS 575/81 new) Sec. 81. Certification recognition. Notwithstanding any 8 rule or provision of law to the contrary, the Business 9 10 Enterprise Program shall recognize and accept the certifications of businesses that have been certified as 11 minority-owned businesses or women-owned businesses by the 12 13 City of Chicago, Cook County, or other entities approved by the Business Enterprise Council for purposes of participating 14

in the Business Enterprise Program, provided that the City of

Chicago, Cook County, or other entities approved by the

- Business Enterprise Council have certification requirements 1
- more restrictive than that required by the Business Enterprise 2
- Program under this Act, including, but not limited to, an 3
- 4 income level requirement.
- Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 5
- becoming law.". 6
