1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 222 2 AMENDMENT NO. . Amend House Bill 222 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 4 changing Section 3-802 and by adding Section 3-699.22 as 5 6 follows: 7 (625 ILCS 5/3-699.22 new) Sec. 3-699.22. Defense Superior Service plates. The 8 Secretary, upon receipt of an application made in the form 9 prescribed by the Secretary, may issue special registration 10 plates designated as Defense Superior Service license plates 11 12 to Illinois residents who have been awarded the Defense

Superior Service Medal by a branch of the armed forces of the

United States. The special plates issued pursuant to this

Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the

first division, motorcycles, and motor vehicles of the second

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- 1 division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. The Secretary may allow the plates to be issued as vanity or personalized 2 3 plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1. The Secretary shall 4 make a version of the special registration plates authorized 5 under this Section in a form appropriate for motorcycles. The design and color of the plates shall be wholly within the 6 discretion of the Secretary. No registration fee, including 7 the fees established under Section 3-806, shall be charged for 8 9 the issuance or renewal of any plates issued under this 10 Section.

- 12 Sec. 3-802. Reclassifications and upgrades.
- 13 (a) Definitions. For the purposes of this Section, the 14 following words shall have the meanings ascribed to them as 15 follows:
- "Reclassification" means changing the registration of a vehicle from one plate category to another.
- "Upgrade" means increasing the registered weight of a vehicle within the same plate category.
 - (b) When reclassing the registration of a vehicle from one plate category to another, the owner shall receive credit for the unused portion of the present plate and be charged the current portion fees for the new plate. In addition, the appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees shall be assessed.

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- 1 (b-5) Any Beginning with the 2019 registration year, any 2 individual who has a registration issued under either Section 3-405 or 3-405.1 that qualifies for a special license plate 3 4 under Section 3-609, 3-609.1, 3-620, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 5 3-624, 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 6 3-651, 3-664, 3-666, 3-667, 3-668, 3-669, 3-676, 3-677, 3-680, 3-681, 3-683, 3-686, 3-688, 3-693, 3-698, 3-699.12, or 7 8 3-699.17, or 3-699.22 may reclass his or her registration upon 9 acquiring a special license plate listed in this subsection 10 (b-5) without a replacement plate or digital plate fee or 11 registration sticker or digital registration sticker cost.
- (b-10) Any Beginning with the 2019 registration year, any 12 13 individual who has a special license plate issued under Section 3-609, 3-609.1, 3-620, 3-621, 3-622, 3-623, 3-624, 14 15 3-625, 3-626, 3-628, 3-638, 3-642, 3-645, 3-647, 3-650, 3-651, 16 3-664, 3-666, 3-667, 3-668, 3-669, 3-676, 3-677, 3-680, 3-681, 3-683, 3-686, 3-688, 3-693, 3-698, 3-699.12, or 17 3-699.22 may reclass his or her special license plate upon 18 acquiring a new registration under Section 3-405 or 3-405.1 19 20 without a replacement plate or digital plate fee or registration sticker or digital registration sticker cost. 21
 - (c) When upgrading the weight of a registration within the same plate category, the owner shall pay the difference in current period fees between the $\underline{2}$ two plates. In addition, the appropriate replacement plate and replacement sticker fees shall be assessed. In the event new plates are not required,

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- 1 the corrected registration card fee shall be assessed.
 - (d) In the event the owner of the vehicle desires to change the registered weight and change the plate category, the owner shall receive credit for the unused portion of registration fee of the current plate and pay the current portion of the registration fee for the new plate, and in appropriate replacement plate pay the and replacement sticker fees.
 - (e) Reclassing from one plate category to another plate category can be done only once within any registration period.
 - (f) No refunds shall be made in any of the circumstances found in subsection (b), subsection (c), or subsection (d); however, when reclassing from a flat weight plate to an apportioned plate, a refund may be issued if the credit amounts to an overpayment.
 - (q) In the event the registration of a vehicle registered under the mileage tax option is revoked, the owner shall be required to pay the annual registration fee in the new plate category and shall not receive any credit for the mileage plate fees.
 - (h) Certain special interest plates may be displayed on first division vehicles, second division vehicles weighing 8,000 pounds or less, and recreational vehicles. Those plates can be transferred within those vehicle groups.
- 25 (i) Plates displayed on second division vehicles weighing 26 8,000 pounds or less and passenger vehicle plates may be

- 1 reclassed from one division to the other.
- 2 (j) Other than in subsection (i), reclassing from one
- 3 division to the other division is prohibited. In addition, a
- reclass from a motor vehicle to a trailer or a trailer to a 4
- 5 motor vehicle is prohibited.
