1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the High-Speed Railway Commission Act.
- 6 Section 5. Commission created; membership.
- 7 (a) There is created the High-Speed Railway Commission to 8 carry out the duties set forth in Section 10.
- 9 (b) The Commission shall be composed of the following 10 members:
- 11 (1) The Governor or his or her designee.
- 12 (2) The President of the Senate or his or her designee.
- 14 (3) The Minority Leader of the Senate or his or her designee.
- 16 (4) The Speaker of the House or his or her designee.
- 17 (5) The Minority Leader of the House or his or her designee.
- 19 (6) The Secretary of Transportation or his or her designee.
- 21 (7) The Chairperson of the Illinois State Toll Highway 22 Authority or his or her designee.
- 23 (8) The Chairperson of the Illinois Commerce

- Commission or his or her designee. 1
- 2 (9) The Chairperson of the Board of Directors of Metra 3 or his or her designee.
- (10) The Mayor of the City of Chicago or his or her designee.
- 6 (11)representative of a labor organization 7 representing rail workers.
  - (12) A representative of a trade organization related to the rail industry.
- 10 (13) A representative of the Metropolitan Mayors and 11 Managers Association.
- 12 (14) A representative from the Illinois Railroad 13 Association.
- (15) A representative from the University of Illinois 14 15 System.
- 16 (16) A representative from the Municipal Planning 17 Organization.
- (17) A representative of the Illinois Municipal 18 19 League.
- 20 (18) A representative of the Champaign-Urbana Mass Transit District. 21
- 22 (c) The Chairperson of the Commission shall be elected 23 from the Commission's membership by a simple majority vote of the total membership of the Commission. The Vice-Chairperson 24 25 of the Commission shall be elected from the Commission's 26 membership by a simple majority vote of the total membership

- 2 (d) The Governor, President of the Senate, Minority Leader
- 3 of the Senate, Speaker of the House of Representatives, and
- 4 Minority Leader of the House of Representatives shall make
- 5 their initial appointments to the Commission by January 1,
- 6 2022.
- 7 (e) Vacancies in Commission membership shall be filled in
- 8 the same manner as initial appointments.
- 9 (f) Total membership of the Commission consists of the
- 10 number of members serving on the Commission, not including any
- 11 vacant positions. A quorum consists of a simple majority of
- 12 total membership and shall be sufficient to conduct the
- business of the Commission, unless stipulated otherwise in the
- 14 bylaws of the Commission.
- 15 (q) The Commission shall meet at least quarterly.
- Section 10. Duties of Commission. The High-Speed Railway
- 17 Commission shall create a statewide plan for a high-speed rail
- 18 line and feeder network connecting St. Louis, Missouri and
- 19 Chicago, Illinois that includes current existing Amtrak and
- 20 Metra services, connects the cities of Rockford, Moline,
- 21 Peoria, and Decatur, and uses inter-city bus service to
- 22 coordinate with the rail line. The Commission shall conduct a
- 23 ridership study and shall make findings and recommendations
- 24 concerning a governance structure, the frequency of service,
- and implementation of the plan. The Commission shall report to

- the General Assembly and the Governor no later than December 1
- 2 31 of each year.
- Section 15. Administrative support. The Department of 3
- Transportation shall provide administrative and other support 4
- 5 to the Commission.
- Section 20. Repeal. This Act is repealed on January 1, 6
- 7 2027.
- 8 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- becoming law.
