

1 AN ACT concerning education.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Act is amended by
5 adding Section 120 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 305/120 new)

7 Sec. 120. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

8 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
9 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
10 menstrual cycle.

11 (b) The Board of Trustees shall make menstrual hygiene
12 products available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms
13 of facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
14 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
15 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
16 administrative purposes.

17 Section 10. The Southern Illinois University Management
18 Act is amended by adding Section 100 as follows:

19 (110 ILCS 520/100 new)

20 Sec. 100. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

21 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means

1 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
2 menstrual cycle.

3 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
4 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
5 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
6 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
7 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
8 administrative purposes.

9 Section 15. The Chicago State University Law is amended by
10 adding Section 5-210 as follows:

11 (110 ILCS 660/5-210 new)

12 Sec. 5-210. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

13 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
14 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
15 menstrual cycle.

16 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
17 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
18 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
19 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
20 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
21 administrative purposes.

22 Section 20. The Eastern Illinois University Law is amended
23 by adding Section 10-210 as follows:

1 (110 ILCS 665/10-210 new)

2 Sec. 10-210. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

3 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
4 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
5 menstrual cycle.

6 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
7 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
8 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
9 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
10 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
11 administrative purposes.

12 Section 25. The Governors State University Law is amended
13 by adding Section 15-210 as follows:

14 (110 ILCS 670/15-210 new)

15 Sec. 15-210. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

16 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
17 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
18 menstrual cycle.

19 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
20 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
21 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
22 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
23 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or

1 administrative purposes.

2 Section 30. The Illinois State University Law is amended
3 by adding Section 20-215 as follows:

4 (110 ILCS 675/20-215 new)

5 Sec. 20-215. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

6 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
7 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
8 menstrual cycle.

9 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
10 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
11 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
12 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
13 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
14 administrative purposes.

15 Section 35. The Northeastern Illinois University Law is
16 amended by adding Section 25-210 as follows:

17 (110 ILCS 680/25-210 new)

18 Sec. 25-210. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

19 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
20 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
21 menstrual cycle.

22 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products

1 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
2 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
3 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
4 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
5 administrative purposes.

6 Section 40. The Northern Illinois University Law is
7 amended by adding Section 30-220 as follows:

8 (110 ILCS 685/30-220 new)

9 Sec. 30-220. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

10 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
11 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
12 menstrual cycle.

13 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
14 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
15 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
16 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
17 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
18 administrative purposes.

19 Section 45. The Western Illinois University Law is amended
20 by adding Section 35-215 as follows:

21 (110 ILCS 690/35-215 new)

22 Sec. 35-215. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

1 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
2 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
3 menstrual cycle.

4 (b) The Board shall make menstrual hygiene products
5 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
6 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
7 leased by the Board or over which the Board has care, custody,
8 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
9 administrative purposes.

10 Section 50. The Public Community College Act is amended by
11 adding Section 3-29.14 as follows:

12 (110 ILCS 805/3-29.14 new)

13 Sec. 3-29.14. Availability of menstrual hygiene products.

14 (a) In this Section, "menstrual hygiene products" means
15 tampons and sanitary napkins for use in connection with the
16 menstrual cycle.

17 (b) Each board shall make menstrual hygiene products
18 available, at no cost to students, in the bathrooms of
19 facilities or portions of facilities that (i) are owned or
20 leased by the board or over which the board has care, custody,
21 and control and (ii) are used for student instruction or
22 administrative purposes.

23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
24 becoming law.
