AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 720

AMENDMENT NO. $\qquad$ . Amend House Bill 720 on page 2, by replacing lines 18 through 22 with the following:
"(c-10) If the roadway is approved for such use by the county sheriff, a person may operate a side-by-side all-terrain vehicle or a recreational off-highway vehicle on a roadway that is not a State highway, federal highway, or within the boundaries of an incorporated area and where the speed limit is 55 miles per hour or less. As used in this subsection, "side-by-side all-terrain vehicle" means an all-terrain vehicle that is equipped with a steering wheel, a bench or bucket-type seating designed for at least 2 people to sit side-by-side, seat belts, a slow moving vehicle emblem, a horn, and a strobe light installed on the vehicle's roof.".
