Amends the Promissory Note and Bank Holiday Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning written instruments expressing a promise to pay or confirming an obligation.

1 AN ACT concerning business.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Promissory Note and Bank Holiday Act is amended by changing Section 3 as follows:
- 6 (815 ILCS 105/3) (from Ch. 17, par. 601)
- 7 Sec. 3. All promissory notes, bonds, due bills and and other instruments in writing, made or to be made, by any 8 9 person, body politic or corporate, whereby such person promises or agrees to pay any sum of money or articles of 10 personal property, or any sum of money in personal property, 11 or acknowledges any sum of money or article of personal 12 13 property to be due to any other person, shall be taken to be 14 due and payable, and the sum of money or article of personal property therein mentioned shall, by virtue thereof, be due 15 16 and payable as therein expressed.
