## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

745 ILCS 49/10

Amends the Good Samaritan Act. Makes a technical change in the Section concerning immunity from civil liability for providing emergency cardiopulmonary resuscitation to an apparent victim of acute cardiopulmonary insufficiency.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The Good Samaritan Act is amended by changing
- 5 Section 10 as follows:
- 6 (745 ILCS 49/10)
- 7 Sec. 10. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation; exemption from
- 8 civil liability for emergency care. Any person trained in
- 9 basic cardiopulmonary resuscitation who has successfully
- 10 completed training in accordance with the the standards of the
- 11 American Red Cross or the American Heart Association and who
- in good faith, not for compensation, provides emergency
- 13 cardiopulmonary resuscitation in accordance with his or her
- 14 training to a person who is an apparent victim of acute
- 15 cardiopulmonary insufficiency shall not, as the result of his
- or her acts or omissions in providing resuscitation, be liable
- for civil damages, unless the acts or omissions constitute
- 18 willful and wanton misconduct.
