# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
amended by changing Section 115-8 as follows:

6 (725 ILCS 5/115-8) (from Ch. 38, par. 115-8)

Sec. 115-8. A defendant may waive his right to be present during trial. However, upon motion of <u>the</u> the State's Attorney made prior to or during trial, the court shall order the defendant to present himself in open court for the purpose of identification.
