1 AN ACT concerning revenue.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Retailers' Occupation Tax Act is amended by 4 5 changing Section 2i as follows:
- (35 ILCS 120/2i) (from Ch. 120, par. 441i) 6
- 7 Sec. 2i. Notwithstanding any other provision to the the contrary, any person who is required to file a bond pursuant to 8 9 any provision of this Act and who has continuously complied with all provisions of this Act for 24 or more consecutive 10 months, shall no longer be required to comply with the bonding 11 provisions of this Act so long as such person continues his 12 compliance with the provisions of this Act. 13
