A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning urban problems.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Urban Renewal Consolidation Act of 1961 is  
5 amended by changing Section 4 as follows:

6 (315 ILCS 30/4) (from Ch. 67 1/2, par. 91.104)

7 Sec. 4. The ~~The~~ governing body of any municipality having  
8 more than 500,000 inhabitants, as determined by the last  
9 preceding Federal census, and in which there exist both a land  
10 clearance commission and a conservation board, by ordinance  
11 adopted by a majority of its members, may determine that there  
12 is need to consolidate the functions of the land clearance  
13 commission and of the conservation board in a single body and  
14 provide for the creation of a Department of Urban Renewal to  
15 operate within the boundaries of such municipality pursuant to  
16 the provisions of this Act.
