SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/5-1a

from Ch. 122, par. 5-1a

Amends the Trustees of Schools Article of the School Code. Provides that the school board of a high school district located in a Class II county school unit may, by proper resolution, withdraw from the jurisdiction and authority of the township treasurer and the trustees of schools of a township in which all or any part of the school district is located. Requires the school board to elect or appoint its own school treasurer. Thereafter, provides that the trustees of schools shall no longer have or exercise any powers and duties with respect to the school district or the school district's business, operations, or assets; requires the township trustees to transfer and deliver to the school board all books and records relating to the school district's business and affairs; and provides that legal title to school buildings and school sites located within the school district shall be deemed transferred by operation of law to and shall vest in the school board. Effective immediately.

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AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section
5 5-1a as follows:

7 Sec. 5-1a. High school districts.

(a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article or 8 9 the School Code, the school board of any high school district that is located in a Class II county school unit and that on or 10 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of 1991 is 11 subject to the jurisdiction and authority of a township 12 treasurer and trustees of schools of a township in which all or 13 14 any part of that school district is located may not withdraw from the jurisdiction and authority of that township treasurer 15 16 and those trustees of schools, by proper resolution, and upon 17 the adoption and passage of the resolution, thereupon elect or appoint its own school treasurer as provided in Section 8-1. 18 19 Upon the adoption and passage of a resolution and the election 20 or appointment by the school board of its own school 21 treasurer: (1) the trustees of schools shall no longer have or 22 exercise any powers and duties with respect to the school district governed by the school board or with respect to the 23

2	and (2) all books and records of the township trustees
3	relating to the school business and affairs of the school
4	district shall be transferred and delivered to the school
5	board of the school district. Upon withdrawal, the legal title
6	to and all right, title, and interest formerly held by the
7	township trustees in any school buildings and school sites
8	used and occupied by the school board of the withdrawing
9	school district for school purposes, that legal title, right,
10	title, and interest thereafter having been transferred to and
11	vested in the regional board of school trustees under Public
12	Act 87-473 until the abolition of that regional board of
13	school trustees by Public Act 87-969, shall be deemed
14	transferred by operation of law to and shall vest in the school
15	board of that school district. and transfer or otherwise
16	submit to the jurisdiction and authority of a township
17	treasurer or trustees of school of another township, unless
18	the school board of each underlying elementary school district
19	whose territory includes all or any part of the territory
20	included within that high school district, by resolution,
21	consents to the proposed withdrawal by the school board of
22	that high school district from the jurisdiction and authority
23	of the township treasurer and trustees of schools of the
24	township to which that high school district is subject and the
25	transfer or other submission by the school board of that high
26	school district to the jurisdiction and authority of a

1 township treasurer or trustees of schools of another township.

2 (b) A high school district that is subject to the jurisdiction and authority of the township treasurer 3 and trustees of schools of a township in which those offices are 4 5 abolished as provided in subsection (c) of Section 5-1 shall 6 thereupon be required to appoint its own school treasurer as 7 provided in paragraph (4) of subsection (c) of Section 5-1 and subsection (c) of Section 8-1, and shall be subject to and 8 governed by the other changes made to the School Code by this 9 10 amendatory Act of 1991, insofar as the same are applicable to a 11 high school district.
