1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1834

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 1834 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Unemployment Insurance Act is amended by
5 adding Section 1707 as follows:

6 (820 ILCS 405/1707 new)

7 Sec. 1707. Pilot program; cost savings; operational
8 efficiencies.

9 (a) In this Section, "payroll data provider" means payroll
10 providers, verification companies, and other commercial or
11 non-commercial entities that collect and maintain data
12 regarding employment and income.

13 (b) In order to achieve cost savings, minimize fraud, and
14 increase unemployment insurance program operational
15 efficiencies, the Department shall participate in a no-cost,
16 90-day pilot program in which it shall obtain real-time

1 employment and income data (up-to-date, non-modeled employment
2 and income data provided by employers and payroll providers)
3 from a payroll data provider that is also a consumer reporting
4 agency, as defined by the federal Fair Credit Reporting Act.

5 (c) Upon the pilot program successfully demonstrating cost
6 savings, the Department shall incorporate such real-time
7 employment and income data into its eligibility determination
8 process."
