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1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The State Finance Act is amended by adding 5 Section 5.935 as follows:

11 Sec. 3-699.14. Universal special license plates.

12 (a) In addition to any other special license plate, the upon receipt of all applicable 13 Secretary, fees and applications made in the form prescribed by the Secretary, may 14 issue Universal special license plates to residents of 15 16 Illinois on behalf of organizations that have been authorized 17 by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special license plates. Appropriate documentation, as determined by 18 19 the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized 20 organizations shall be designated by amendment to this Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate 21

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the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the 1 2 authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a 3 decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record of that organization and that organization shall remain 4 5 affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered, revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization 6 may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and 7 8 distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the 9 authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct 10 from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal, 11 sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal 12 special license plate other than a decal authorized by the General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal 13 14 sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be 15 affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, 16 including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the 17 second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the 18 multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code. 19

(b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. 1 Universal special license plates shall comply with rules adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and 2 3 approval of Universal special license plate decals. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal 4 5 special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The 6 7 Secretary of State must make a version of the special 8 registration plates authorized under this Section in a form 9 appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.

10 (c) When authorizing a Universal special license plate, 11 the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee 12 is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged, 13 the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed. When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a 14 15 special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be 16 deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate. 17 Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in 18 compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of 19 20 the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act. Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal 21 22 special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of 23 State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General verifying that the entity is in compliance with the Charitable 24 25 Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act.

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(d) Upon original issuance and for each registration

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renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration 1 2 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional 3 fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the 4 5 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State 6 7 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into 8 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the 9 organization to issue decals for Universal special license 10 plates. All money in the designated fund shall be distributed 11 by the Secretary subject to appropriation by the General 12 Assembly.

All money in the Theresa Tracy Trot -4 Illinois CancerCare Foundation Fund shall be paid to the 5 Illinois CancerCare Foundation for the purpose of 6 furthering pancreatic cancer research.

7 (8) (4) The Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund. 8 All money in the Developmental Disabilities Awareness Fund 9 shall moneys to be paid as grants to the Illinois 10 Department of Human Services to fund legal aid groups to 11 assist with guardianship fees for private citizens willing 12 to become guardians for individuals with developmental 13 disabilities but who are unable to pay the legal fees 14 associated with becoming a guardian.

15 <u>(9)</u> (4) The Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund. All <u>money</u> 16 <u>in the Pediatric Cancer Awareness Fund shall</u> moneys to be 17 paid as grants to the Cancer Center at Illinois for 18 pediatric cancer treatment and research.

19 (10) The Experimental Aircraft Association Fund. All 20 money in the Experimental Aircraft Association Fund shall 21 be paid, subject to appropriation by the General Assembly 22 and distribution by the Secretary, as grants to promote 23 recreational aviation.
