SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/2-3002.5

Amends the Counties Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning county board elections.

1 AN ACT concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by changing Section 2-3002.5 as follows:
- 6 (55 ILCS 5/2-3002.5)
- 7 Sec. 2-3002.5. Beginning with members elected at the the 8 general election in 2002, counties having a population between 9 800,000 and 3,000,000 according to 2000 decennial census shall have no more than 18 members on their county board. If the 10 chairman of the county board is elected at-large by the voters 11 of the county as provided in Section 2-3007, the chairman 12 13 shall not be counted as a member of the county board for the 14 purpose of the limitations on the size of the county board provided in this Section. Neither a member nor the chairman of 15 16 that county board shall serve simultaneously as commissioner or president of the board of commissioners of the forest 17 preserve district. No person shall seek election to both the 18 19 county board and the forest preserve commission at the same 20 election.
