SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

240 ILCS 40/1-5

Amends the Grain Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the purpose of the Code.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Sec. 1-5. Purpose. It is the the primary purpose of this 8 Code to promote the State's welfare by improving the economic 9 stability of agriculture through the existence of the Illinois Grain Insurance Fund in order to protect producers in the 10 event of the failure of a licensed grain dealer or licensed 11 warehouseman and to ensure the existence of an adequate 12 13 resource so that persons holding valid claims mav be 14 compensated for losses occasioned by the failure of a licensed grain dealer or licensed warehouseman. To that end, this Code 15 16 shall be liberally construed and liberally administered in favor of claimants. 17

In addition, the Illinois grain industry comprises a significant and vital part of the State's economy and as such can function to its fullest competitive and profitable potential, thus contributing to the economic health of this State, when it operates under a coordinated and integrated regulatory structure. Thus, a further purpose of this Code is

- 1 to provide a single system of governmental regulation of the
