- 4 Section 5. The Recreational Use of Land and Water Areas
- 5 Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (745 ILCS 65/1) (from Ch. 70, par. 31)
- 7 Sec. 1. This Act shall be known <u>and</u> may be cited as the
- 8 "Recreational Use of Land and Water Areas Act".
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to encourage owners of land to
- 10 make land and water areas available to any individual or
- 11 members of the public for recreational or conservation
- 12 purposes by limiting their liability toward persons entering
- thereon for such purposes.
