Section 5. The Illinois Hydraulic Fracturing Tax Act is
amended by changing Section 2-75 as follows:

6 (35 ILCS 450/2-75)

Sec. 2-75. Distribution of proceeds. All moneys received
by the Department under this Act shall be paid into the General
Revenue Fund in the State treasury <u>and shall be used only for</u>
<u>the payment of pension obligations of the State of Illinois</u>.
