

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB2573

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

25 ILCS 120/7 new

Amends the Compensation Review Act. Provides that members of the General Assembly are prohibited from receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living adjustment for or during the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021. Provides that members of the General Assembly are prohibited from receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living adjustment for terms commencing on or after July 1, 2021, unless otherwise approved by law. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Compensation Review Act is amended by adding Section 7 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 7. General Assembly COLAs prohibited.</u>
- (a) Notwithstanding any former or current provision of 8 9 this Act, any other law, any report of the Compensation Review Board, or any resolution of the General Assembly to the 10 contrary, members of the General Assembly are prohibited from 11 12 receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living 13 14 adjustment, as authorized by Senate Joint Resolution 192 of the 86th General Assembly, for or during the fiscal year 15 16 beginning July 1, 2021.
 - (b) Notwithstanding any former or current provision of this Act, any other law, any report of the Compensation Review Board, or any resolution of the General Assembly to the contrary, members of the General Assembly are prohibited from receiving and shall not receive any increase in compensation that would otherwise apply based on a cost of living adjustment, as authorized by Senate Joint Resolution 192 of
