- Section 40. The sum of \$18,000,000, or so much thereof as 3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police 4 5 Whistleblower Reward and Protection Fund to the Department of State Police for payment of their expenditures for state law 6 enforcement purposes in accordance with the State Whistleblower 7 Protection Act. 8
- 9 Section 45. The sum of \$32,000,000, or so much thereof as 10 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police 11 12 for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred by the Department of State Police. 13
- 14 Section 50. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as 15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police 16 17 for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Safe2Help 18 Program.
- 19 Section 55. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as 20 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Operations Assistance Fund to the Department of State Police 21

- 1 for expenses related to officer-worn body cameras.
- 2 Section 60. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may
- 3 be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Streetgang-
- 4 Related Crime Fund to the Department of State Police for
- 5 operations related to streetgang-related crime initiatives.
- 6 Section 65. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Over Dimensional
- 8 Load Police Escort Fund to the Department of State Police for
- 9 expenses incurred for providing police escorts for over-
- 10 dimensional loads.
- 11 Section 70. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
- 12 be necessary, is appropriated from the Medicaid Fraud and Abuse
- 13 Prevention Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of
- 14 Operations, for the detection, investigation or prosecution of
- 15 recipient or vendor fraud.
- Section 75. The sum of \$13,000,000, or so much thereof as
- may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Police Law
- 18 Enforcement Administration Fund to the Department of State
- 19 Police, Division of Operations, for all costs associated with
- 20 a cadet program for the Department of State Police.

18	Identification Card Act.
19	Section 100. The sum of \$22,000,000, or so much thereof
20	as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
21	Police from the State Police Firearm Services Fund for expenses
22	as outlined in the Firearm Concealed Carry Act and the Firearm
23	Owners Identification Card Act.

- 1 Section 105. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
- 2 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
- 3 Police, Division of Forensic Services and Identification, from
- 4 the Firearm Dealer License Certification Fund, for expenses as
- 5 outlined in the Firearm Dealer License Certification Act and
- 6 the Gun Trafficking Information Act.
- 7 Section 110. The sum of \$62,800, or so much thereof as may
- 8 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of State
- 9 Police, Division of Internal Investigation, from the General
- 10 Revenue Fund for the ordinary and contingent expenses incurred
- 11 while operating the Nursing Home Identified Offender Program.
- 12 Section 115. The sum of \$230,000,000, or so much thereof
- as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Statewide 9-1-1
- 14 Fund to the Department of State Police, Division of Justice
- Services, for costs pursuant to the Emergency Telephone System
- 16 Act.
- 17 Section 999. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
- 18 1, 2021.
