20 ILCS 3903/25

Amends the Illinois African-American Family Commission Act. Provides that the annual funding allocation for the Illinois African-American Family Commission shall be no less than \$1,000,000.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois African-American Family Commission
5 Act is amended by changing Section 25 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 3903/25)

7 Sec. 25. Funding. The African-American Family Commission
8 may receive funding through appropriations available for its
9 purposes made to the Department on Aging, the Department of
10 Children and Family Services, the Department of Commerce and
11 Economic Opportunity, the Department of Corrections, the
12 Department of Human Services, the Department of Healthcare and
13 Family Services, the Department of Public Health, the State
14 Board of Education, the Board of Higher Education, the
15 Illinois Community College Board, the Department of Human
16 Rights, the Capital Development Board, the Department of
17 Labor, and the Department of Transportation. The Commission
18 may also receive and expend funding from federal and private
19 sources, including gifts, donations, and private grants. The
20 annual funding allocation for the Commission shall be no less
21 than \$1,000,000.
