

102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB2813

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-808.2 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that no vehicle owned and operated by the State, a unit of local government, or a subsidiary body thereof shall display nongovernmental license plates. Provides that every vehicle owned and operated by a unit of local government, or any subsidiary body thereof, shall affix a sticker or decal that clearly denotes the unit of local government to which the vehicle belongs, to the license plate or, if necessary, the rear of the vehicle within 6 inches of the license plate, such that it is plainly visible to a vehicle approaching from behind. Exempts vehicles being used in undercover police operations. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning transportation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding

 Section 3-808.2 as follows:
- 6 (625 ILCS 5/3-808.2 new)
- Sec. 3-808.2. Prohibition of private plates on public
- 8 <u>vehicles.</u>
- 9 (a) No vehicle owned and operated by the State, a unit of
- 10 <u>local government, or a subsidiary body thereof shall display</u>
- 11 <u>nongovernmental license plates.</u>
- 12 (b) Every vehicle owned and operated by a unit of local
- government, or any subsidiary body thereof, shall affix a
- 14 <u>sticker or decal that clearly denotes the unit of local</u>
- government to which the vehicle belongs to the license plate
- or, if necessary, the rear of the vehicle within 6 inches of
- the license plate, such that it is plainly visible to a vehicle
- 18 <u>approaching from behind.</u>
- (c) This Section does not apply to vehicles being used in
- 20 <u>undercover police operations.</u>
- 21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 22 becoming law.
