### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

40 ILCS 5/1-155 new

Amends the General Provisions Article of the Illinois Pension Code. Provides that beginning on the effective date of the amendatory Act, the minimum age at which a person is eligible to receive a retirement annuity or pension under any Article of the Code shall be increased by one year and, beginning 5 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act, the minimum age at which a person is eligible to receive a retirement annuity or pension under any Article of the Code shall be increased by one additional year. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Pension Code is amended by adding  
5 Section 1-155 as follows:

6 (40 ILCS 5/1-155 new)

7 Sec. 1-155. Retirement age; increase. Notwithstanding any  
8 other provision of law, beginning on the effective date of  
9 this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly, the minimum  
10 age at which a person is eligible to receive a retirement  
11 annuity or pension under any Article of this Code shall be  
12 increased by one year and, beginning 5 years after the  
13 effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General  
14 Assembly, shall be increased by one additional year.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
16 becoming law.
