SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

815 ILCS 505/2WWW new

Amends the Consumer Fraud and Deceptive Business Practices Act. Prohibits the advertising of nonwoven disposal products unless the product is flushable, septic safe, or sewer safe as provided by the Federal Trade Commission in Docket No. C-4556.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 9 (1) "Flushable, septic safe, or sewer safe" means a
 10 nonwoven disposable product that meets the tests for
 11 flushability established by the Federal Trade Commission
 12 in Docket No. C-4556 for non-misleading representations
 13 regarding the flushability of nonwoven disposable
 14 products.
- 15 (2) "Nonwoven disposable product" means a product

 16 constructed from nonwoven sheets, including moist toilet

 17 tissue or cloth, that is designed, marketed, or commonly

 18 used for personal hygiene purposes.
 - (b) No nonwoven disposable product for sale in this State may be advertised as flushable, septic safe, or sewer safe unless it meets the definition set forth in paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of this Section.
- 23 (c) A violation of this Section constitutes an unlawful
