#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 420/3A-50 new

Amends the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act. Provides that a person, regardless of citizenship or immigration status, is eligible to be appointed to any board, commission, authority, or task force authorized or created by State law or by executive order of the Governor if the person is 18 years of age and a resident of the State.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Governmental Ethics Act is amended  
5 by adding Section 3A-50 as follows:

7 Sec. 3A-50. Immigrant appointees. Notwithstanding any  
8 provision of law to the contrary, a person, regardless of  
9 citizenship or immigration status, is eligible to be appointed  
10 to any board, commission, authority, or task force authorized  
11 or created by State law or by executive order of the Governor  
12 if the person is 18 years of age and a resident of the State.
