2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Alternate Fuels Act is amended by changing  
5 Section 5 as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 120/5)

7 Sec. 5. Purpose. The ~~The~~ General Assembly declares that it  
8 is the public policy of the State to promote and encourage the  
9 use of alternate fuel in vehicles as a means to improve air  
10 quality in the State and to meet the requirements of the  
11 federal Clean Air Act Amendments of 1990 and the federal  
12 Energy Policy Act of 1992. The General Assembly further  
13 declares that the State can play a leadership role in the  
14 development of vehicles powered by alternate fuels, as well as  
15 in the establishment of the necessary infrastructure to  
16 support this emerging technology.
