5 ILCS 220/3.10 new

Amends the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act. Provides that any 2 or more school districts may, by intergovernmental agreement, establish a mutually beneficial technology exchange program to provide for the sharing of education resources, including computers, tablets, electronic readers, and other technology.

3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Intergovernmental Cooperation Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 3.10 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 220/3.10 new)

7 Sec. 3.10. School district technology exchange. Any 2 or  
8 more school districts as governed under the School Code may,  
9 by intergovernmental agreement, establish a mutually  
10 beneficial technology exchange program to provide for the  
11 sharing of education resources, including computers, tablets,  
12 electronic readers, and other technology.
