### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 465/11 new

Amends the Flag Display Act. Provides for the procedure and the occasions in which the United States national flag shall be flown at half-staff. Defines "half-staff".

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Flag Display Act is amended by adding
Section 11 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 465/11 new)

7 Sec. 11. Display of flag at half-staff. The United States national flag, when flown at half-staff, should be first 8 9 hoisted to the peak for an instant and then lowered to the 10 half-staff position. The flag should be again raised to the peak before it is lowered for the day. On Memorial Day, the 11 12 flag should be displayed at half-staff until noon only, then raised to the top of the staff. By order of the Governor, the 13 14 flag shall be flown at half-staff upon the death of a present or former official of the government, the death of a member of 15 the Armed Forces who dies while serving on active duty, the 16 death of a first responder who dies while serving in the line 17 of duty, or any other death or occurrence that the Governor 18 19 deems worthy of such a recognition. An order of the Governor to 20 fly the flag at half-staff may be for any length of time up to 21 the greatest length of time enumerated in Section 7 of the 22 United States Flag Code. For the purposes of this Section, "half-staff" means the position of the flag when it is 23

1 <u>one-half the distance between the top and bottom of the staff.</u>
