SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

5 ILCS 420/2-105 new

Amends the Illinois Governmental Ethics Act. Provides that no legislator shall receive any income derived from his or her ownership of any gaming-related interest. Requires any legislator holding ownership in a gaming-related interest from which he or she may derive income to divest himself or herself of that interest.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Governmental Ethics Act is amended
by adding Section 2-105 as follows:

(5 ILCS 420/2-105 new) 6 7 Sec. 2-105. Gaming-related interest; income prohibited. No legislator shall receive any income derived from his or her 8 ownership of any gaming-related interest. Any legislator 9 10 holding ownership in a gaming-related interest from which he 11 or she may derive income as of the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly shall divest 12 himself or herself of that interest as soon as practicable 13 14 after the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 102nd General Assembly. 15
