SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

720 ILCS 570/316.5 new

Amends the Illinois Controlled Substances Act. Provides that a prescriber shall provide information to all patients receiving a prescription for opioids on overdose prevention and the use of naloxone hydrochloride or another drug approved by the United States Food and Drug Administration for the complete or partial reversal of opioid depression.

4 Section 5. The Illinois Controlled Substances Act is
5 amended by adding Section 316.5 as follows:

7 Sec. 316.5. Naloxone Education. A prescriber shall provide
8 information to all patients receiving a prescription for
9 opioids on overdose prevention and the use of naloxone
10 hydrochloride or another drug approved by the United States
11 Food and Drug Administration for the complete or partial
12 reversal of opioid depression.
