## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

New Act

Creates the Technology Addiction Notice Act. Provides that an operator of a social media website must include on its social media website a hyperlink that directs users to resources related to technology addiction. The hyperlink must be visible on each page in the social media website.

1 AN ACT concerning business.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 1. Short title. This Act may be cited as the Technology Addiction Notice Act.
- 6 Section 5. Definitions. In this Act:
  - "Operator" means a private entity that owns a social media website that provides a service to a consumer residing in this State. "Operator" does not include a third party that operates, hosts, or manages, but does not own, a website or online service on the owner's behalf or that processes information on behalf of the owner.
    - "Social media website" means an electronic medium by means of which users may create and view user-generated content, such as uploaded or downloaded videos or still photographs, blogs, video blogs, podcasts, or instant messages. "Social Media website" does not include any medium that has fewer than 10,000 daily users residing in this State.
- Section 10. Technology addiction notice required. An operator shall include on its social media website a hyperlink that directs users to resources related to technology addiction. The hyperlink must be visible on each page in the

- 1 social media website and shall contain the phrase: "Learn more
- 2 about internet and technology addiction.".
