

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB3678

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

705 ILCS 305/18 rep. 725 ILCS 5/112-2

from Ch. 38, par. 112-2

Amends the Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963. Changes the oath taken by grand jurors. Amends the Jury Act to delete a duplicative provision concerning the oath taken by the foreman of a Grand Jury. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 5 Section 5. The Jury Act is amended by repealing Section
- 6 18.
- 7 Section 10. The Code of Criminal Procedure of 1963 is
- 8 amended by changing Section 112-2 as follows:
- 9 (725 ILCS 5/112-2) (from Ch. 38, par. 112-2)
- 10 Sec. 112-2. Impaneling the Grand Jury. (a) The Grand Jury
- shall consist of 16 persons, 12 of whom shall be necessary to
- 12 constitute a quorum.
- 13 (b) The Grand Jury shall be impaneled, sworn and
- instructed as to its duties by the court. The court shall
- 15 select and swear one of the grand jurors to serve as foreman.
- 16 (c) Before the Grand Jury shall enter upon the discharge
- of their duties the following oath shall be administered to
- 18 the jurors:
- "Do each of you swear (or affirm) that you will diligently
- 20 inquire into all matters presented to you; that you will
- 21 return no indictment through malice or ill will, or fail to
- 22 return one due to fear or reward; and that in all your

decisions you will present the truth, the whole truth, and 1 nothing but the truth, according to the best of your skill and 2 understanding. You and each of you do solemnly swear (or 3 affirm, as the case may be), that you will diligently inquire 4 5 into and true presentment make of all such matters and things as shall be given you in charge, or shall otherwise come to 6 your knowledge, touching the present service; you shall 7 present no person through malice, hatred or ill will; nor 8 9 shall you leave any unpresented through fear, favor, affection, or for any fee or reward, or for any hope or promise 10 11 thereof; but in all of your presentments, you shall present the truth, the whole truth, and nothing but the truth, 12 according to the best of your skill and understanding; so help 13 vou God." 14 (Source: P.A. 85-690.) 15

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon becoming law.
