### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 330/8d new 210 ILCS 85/6.14h new

Amends the University of Illinois Hospital Act and the Hospital Licensing Act. Requires a hospital organized or licensed under those Acts to provide a patient who is treated for opioid overdose at the hospital with one dose of or one prescription for an opioid antagonist upon discharge from the hospital, free of charge.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The University of Illinois Hospital Act is 5 amended by adding Section 8d as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 330/8d new)

Sec. 8d. Opioid antagonist dose. The University of Illinois Hospital shall provide a patient who is treated for opioid overdose at the University of Illinois Hospital with one dose of or one prescription for an opioid antagonist upon discharge from the University of Illinois Hospital, free of charge.

Section 10. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by adding Section 6.14h as follows:

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(210 ILCS 85/6.14h new)

Sec. 6.14h. Opioid antagonist dose. A hospital licensed under this Act shall provide a patient who is treated for opioid overdose at the hospital with one dose of or one prescription for an opioid antagonist upon discharge from the hospital, free of charge.
