Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that a driver approaching a stop intersection indicated by a stop sign shall stop before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection.

AN ACT concerning transportation.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 changing Section 11-1204 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/11-1204) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 11-1204)

7 Sec. 11-1204. Stop and yield signs.

8 (a) Preferential right-of-way at an intersection may be 9 indicated by stop signs or yield signs as authorized in 10 Section 11-302 of this Act.

(b) Except when directed to proceed by a police officer or 11 traffic control signal, every driver of a vehicle and every 12 13 motorman of a streetcar approaching a stop intersection 14 indicated by a stop sign shall stop before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, in the event 15 16 there is no crosswalk, shall stop at a clearly marked stop 17 line, but if none, before entering the crosswalk on the near side of the intersection, or if none, then at the point nearest 18 19 the intersection roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before 20 entering the intersection. 21

(c) The driver of a vehicle approaching a yield sign ifrequired for safety to stop shall stop before entering the

1 crosswalk on the near side of the intersection or, in the event 2 there is no crosswalk, at a clearly marked stop line, but if 3 none, then at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where 4 the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the 5 intersecting roadway.
