AN ACT concerning education. 1

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

Section 5. The School Code is amended by changing Section 4 5 14-1.11a as follows:

(105 ILCS 5/14-1.11a) (from Ch. 122, par. 14-1.11a) 6 7 Sec. 14-1.11a. Resident district; student. The resident district is the school district in which the student resides 8 9 when: (1) the parent has legal guardianship but the location 10 11 of the parent is unknown; or 12 (2) an individual guardian has been appointed but the location of the guardian is unknown; or 13 14 (3) the student is 18 years of age or older and no legal guardian has been appointed; or 15 16 (4) the student is legally an emancipated minor; or 17 (5) an Illinois public agency has legal guardianship and such agency or any court in this State has placed the 18 19 student residentially outside of the school district in which the parent lives. 20 21 In cases where an Illinois public agency has legal 22 quardianship and has placed the student residentially outside of Illinois, the last school district that provided at least

45 days of educational service to the student shall continue to be the district of residence until the student is no longer under guardianship of an Illinois public agency or until the student is returned to Illinois.

5 The resident district of a homeless student is the 6 Illinois district in which the student enrolls for educational 7 services. Homeless students include individuals as defined in 8 the Stewart B. McKinney Homeless Assistance Act.

9 The State Superintendent of Education may determine that 10 the location of the parent or guardian of a student is unknown 11 after considering information submitted from the school 12 district that last enrolled the student or from the school or special education facility providing special education and 13 14 related services to meet the needs of the student. The 15 information submitted to the State Superintendent of Education 16 must include an affidavit from that school district's 17 superintendent or the facility's director attesting that the 18 location of the parent or guardian is unknown and 4 items of 19 documentary evidence that a minimum of 4 separate attempts were made to locate the parent or quardian. Any determination 20 21 by the State Superintendent of Education that the location of 22 a parent or quardian is unknown is final. However, any 23 determination made by the State Superintendent of Education is 24 subject to review and reconsideration any time a parent's or 25 quardian's location becomes known.
