#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 312/15 new

Amends the Infectious Disease Testing Act. Provides that, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any requirement for a person to demonstrate proof of COVID-19 vaccination shall be deemed to be met if proof of the presence of COVID-19 antibodies is provided by that person. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Infectious Disease Testing Act is amended  
5 by adding Section 15 as follows:

6 (410 ILCS 312/15 new)

7 Sec. 15. COVID-19 antibodies; vaccination requirements.

8 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any  
9 requirement for a person to demonstrate proof of COVID-19  
10 vaccination shall be deemed to be met if proof of the presence  
11 of COVID-19 antibodies is provided by that person.

12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
13 becoming law.
