SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

410 ILCS 312/15 new

Amends the Infectious Disease Testing Act. Provides that, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any requirement for a person to demonstrate proof of COVID-19 vaccination shall be deemed to be met if proof of the presence of COVID-19 antibodies is provided by that person. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Infectious Disease Testing Act is amended
- 5 by adding Section 15 as follows:
- 6 (410 ILCS 312/15 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 15. COVID-19 antibodies; vaccination requirements.</u>
- 8 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any
- 9 requirement for a person to demonstrate proof of COVID-19
- 10 vaccination shall be deemed to be met if proof of the presence
- of COVID-19 antibodies is provided by that person.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 13 becoming law.
