SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

110 ILCS 949/27 new

Amends the Loan Repayment Assistance for Physicians Act. To address the shortage of obstetrical services in rural communities, provides that a physician who provides obstetrical care and works at a privately owned rural health clinic in this State may qualify for assistance under the Act if all other established criteria are met. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Loan Repayment Assistance for Physicians
5 Act is amended by adding Section 27 as follows:

6 (110 ILCS 949/27 new)

7 Sec. 27. Additional eligibility; Rural obstetrical
8 services. To address the shortage of obstetrical services in
9 rural communities, a physician who provides obstetrical care
10 and works at a privately owned rural health clinic in this
11 State may qualify for assistance under the program if all
12 other established criteria are met.

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
14 becoming law.
