1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4384

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4384 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
5 adding Section 30-60 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 500/30-60 new)

7 Sec. 30-60. Request for change orders.

8 (a) Within 45 days after the date that a written request
9 for a change order is submitted by a contractor to a State
10 agency or within 45 days after the date that authorization for
11 extra work is issued by a State agency to a contractor, the
12 State agency shall: (i) issue the change order with an
13 agreement on price; (ii) agree on price for the authorization
14 for extra work; (iii) counter on price in writing; (iv) give
15 written notice to the contractor of the reasons why the change
16 order is unreasonable; (v) accept a partial agreement on price

1 on some of the terms of the change order or extra work; or (vi)
2 explain in writing that an additional 30 days are necessary to
3 make a determination.

4 (b) If an additional 30 days is requested under subsection
5 (a), then, after the 30 additional days have elapsed, the
6 State agency shall: (i) issue the change order with an
7 agreement on price; (ii) agree on price for the authorization
8 for extra work; (iii) counter on price in writing; (iv) give
9 written notice to the contractor of the reasons why the change
10 order is unreasonable; (v) accept a partial agreement on price
11 on some of the terms of the change order or extra work; or (vi)
12 explain in writing that an additional 15 days are necessary to
13 make a determination. If an additional 15 days is requested
14 under this subsection (b), then, after every 15 additional
15 days that elapse, as necessary, the State agency shall perform
16 one of the actions specified in items (i) through (vi) of this
17 subsection (b).

18 (c) The State agency shall report quarterly on its website
19 the total number of times the State agency requested
20 additional time to make a determination under this Section and
21 the total number of times the State agency requested
22 additional time for such determination for each contract.

23 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
24 becoming law."
