SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

515 ILCS 5/10-100

from Ch. 56, par. 10-100

Amends the Fish and Aquatic Life Code. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the unlawful release or introduction of aquatic life.

1 AN ACT concerning fish.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Fish and Aquatic Life Code is amended by 5 changing Section 10-100 as follows:

6 (515 ILCS 5/10-100) (from Ch. 56, par. 10-100)

7 Sec. 10-100. Release of aquatic life.

8 (a) It shall be unlawful to release any aquatic life into 9 the the wild in this State without first securing permission of the Department to do so, except that the owner of a body of 10 water may release aquatic life indigenous to the State of 11 Illinois into waters wholly upon his or her property. The 12 13 Department shall have the authority to promulgate necessary 14 rules and regulations, under the Illinois Administrative Procedure Act, regulating the possession, transportation, and 15 16 shipping of aquatic life not indigenous to the State of 17 Illinois. All aquatic life may be immediately returned unharmed from where they were taken. A violation of this 18 19 subsection (a) is a Class B misdemeanor.

20 (b) It is unlawful to possess, transport, or release any 21 live specimen or viable gametes of any species listed as 22 injurious by administrative rule, unless authorized by that 23 rule. A violation of this subsection (b) is a Class A HB4895
