### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-806	from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-806
625 ILCS 5/3-819	from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 3-819

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Reduces the registration fee for motor vehicles of the first division from \$148 to \$2. Lowers the annual flat weight tax and registration fee for trailers with a gross weight of 3,000 pounds or less from \$36 to \$5.

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AN ACT concerning transportation.

# 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by 5 changing Sections 3-806 and 3-819 as follows:

Sec. 3-806. Registration Fees; Motor Vehicles of the First Division. Every owner of any other motor vehicle of the first division, except as provided in Sections 3-804, 3-804.01, 3-804.3, 3-805, 3-806.3, 3-806.7, and 3-808, and every second division vehicle weighing 8,000 pounds or less, shall pay the Secretary of State an annual registration fee at the following rates:

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2 Motorcycles, Motor Driven

3 Cycles and Pedalcycles

A \$1 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles, motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be deposited into the State Police Vehicle Fund.

8 All of the proceeds of the additional fees imposed by 9 Public Act 96-34 shall be deposited into the Capital Projects 10 Fund.

A \$2 surcharge shall be collected in addition to the above 11 12 fees for motor vehicles of the first division, autocycles, motorcycles, motor driven cycles, and pedalcycles to be 13 deposited into the Park and Conservation Fund for the 14 Department of Natural Resources to use for conservation 15 16 efforts. The monies deposited into the Park and Conservation 17 Fund under this Section shall not be subject to administrative 18 charges or chargebacks unless otherwise authorized by this 19 Act.

Of the fees collected for motor vehicles of the first division other than Autocycles, Motorcycles, Motor Driven Cycles, and Pedalcycles, \$1 of the fees shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special Services Fund and \$49 of the fees shall be deposited into the Road Fund.

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Sec. 3-819. Trailer; tax.

3 Farm Trailer. Any farm trailer drawn by a motor (a) vehicle of the second division registered under paragraph (a) 4 5 or (c) of Section 3-815 and used exclusively by the owner for his own agricultural, horticultural or livestock raising 6 7 operations and not used for hire, or any farm trailer utilized 8 only in the transportation for-hire of seasonal, fresh, 9 perishable fruit or vegetables from farm to the point of first 10 processing, and any trailer used with a farm tractor that is 11 not an implement of husbandry may be registered under this 12 paragraph in lieu of registration under paragraph (b) of this 13 Section upon the filing of a proper application and the payment of the \$10 registration fee and the highway use tax 14 15 herein for use of the public highways of this State, at the 16 following rates which include the \$10 registration fee:

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2 (b) All other owners of trailers, other than apportionable 3 trailers registered under Section 3-402.1 of this Code, used with a motor vehicle on the public highways, shall pay to the 4 5 Secretary of State for each registration year a flat weight tax, for the use of the public highways of this State, at the 6 7 following rates (which includes the registration fee of \$10 8 required by Section 3-813): 9 SCHEDULE OF TRAILER FLAT 10 WEIGHT TAX REQUIRED 11 BY LAW 12 Gross Weight in Lbs. 25 Of the fees collected under this subsection, other than 26 the fee collected for a Class UT or TA trailer, \$1 of the fees

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shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special
Services Fund and \$99 of the fees shall be deposited into the
Road Fund.

4 (c) The number of axles necessary to carry the maximum 5 load provided shall be determined from Chapter 15 of this 6 Code.
