

## 102ND GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2021 and 2022 HB5348

Introduced 1/31/2022, by Rep. Thomas M. Bennett

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/27-2.5 new

Amends the School Code. Allows a school board to discontinue, by publicly adopted resolution, any instructional mandate in the Courses of Study Article of the School Code unless a separate State appropriation is made for the school district that provides full funding for the specific instructional mandate (with exceptions). Provides that if a student requests information on any instructional mandate that has been discontinued, then the school district shall provide the student with the requested information. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 27-2.5 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/27-2.5 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 27-2.5. Instructional mandate discontinuance.</u>
- 8 (a) For the purposes of this Section, "instructional
- 9 mandate" means any State law in this Article that requires a
- 10 school district to devote any amount of time to the
- instruction of or engagement by students in a subject or
- 12 course.
- 13 (b) Notwithstanding Section 2-3.25g or any other provision
- of this Code, a school board may discontinue, by publicly
- 15 <u>adopted resolution, any instructional mandate in this Article</u>
- 16 <u>unless a separate State appropriation, other than funding</u>
- 17 received by the school district under Section 18-8.15 of this
- 18 Code, is made for the school district that provides full
- 19 funding for the specific instructional mandate. This Section,
- 20 however, does not permit a school board to discontinue by
- 21 resolution the requirements set forth in Sections 27-5, 27-6,
- 22 27-7, and 27-22 of this Code and Sections 27-24 through
- 23 27-24.8 of this Code.
