SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/3-808.2 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that no vehicle owned and operated by the State, a unit of local government, or a subsidiary body thereof shall display nongovernmental license plates. Provides that every vehicle owned and operated by a unit of local government, or any subsidiary body thereof, shall affix a sticker or decal that clearly denotes the unit of local government to which the vehicle belongs, to the license plate or, if necessary, the rear of the vehicle within 6 inches of the license plate, such that it is plainly visible to a vehicle approaching from behind. Exempts vehicles being used in undercover police operations. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
5 Section 3-808.2 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/3-808.2 new)

7 Sec. 3-808.2. Prohibition of private plates on public
8 vehicles.

9 (a) No vehicle owned and operated by the State, a unit of
10 local government, or a subsidiary body thereof shall display
11 nongovernmental license plates.

12 (b) Every vehicle owned and operated by a unit of local
13 government, or any subsidiary body thereof, shall affix a
14 sticker or decal that clearly denotes the unit of local
15 government to which the vehicle belongs to the license plate
16 or, if necessary, the rear of the vehicle within 6 inches of
17 the license plate, such that it is plainly visible to a vehicle
18 approaching from behind.

19 (c) This Section does not apply to vehicles being used in
20 undercover police operations.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
22 becoming law.
