SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

625 ILCS 5/13C-21 new

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Provides that by August 1, 2022, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency shall adopt rules to implement the motor vehicle emission standards of the State of California, including the zero-emission vehicle program, and shall amend the rules from time to time to maintain consistency with the California motor vehicle emission standards and federal clean air laws. Provides that such regulations may incorporate by reference the California motor vehicle standards established in final regulations issued by the California Air Resources Board and promulgated under the California Health and Safety Code. Effective immediately.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by adding
Section 13C-21 as follows:

7 Sec. 13C-21. Vehicle emissions testing standards. By August 1, 2022, the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency 8 9 shall adopt rules to implement the motor vehicle emission standards of the State of California, including the 10 zero-emission vehicle program, and shall amend the rules from 11 12 time to time to maintain consistency with the California motor vehicle emission standards and Section 177 of the Federal 13 14 Clean Air Act. Such regulations may incorporate by reference the California motor vehicle standards established in final 15 regulations issued by the California Air Resources Board 16 pursuant to Title 13 of the California Code of Regulations and 17 promulgated under the authority of Division 26 of the 18 19 California Health and Safety Code.

20 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 21 becoming law.
