Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	ARTICLE 1
5	Section 5. In addition to any other sums appropriated, the
6	sum of \$405,377,800 or so much thereof as may be necessary, is
7	appropriated from the Title III Social Security and Employment
8	Fund to the Department of Employment Security for operational
9	expenses, awards, grants, and permanent improvements for the
10	fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, including prior year costs.
11	Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof
12	as may be necessary, are appropriated to the Department of
13	Employment Security:

14	Section 25. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
15	be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to

17	contingent expenses related to the implementation of Automatic
18	Voter Registration.
19	Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July
20	1, 2022.
