Section 40. The sum of \$2,600,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Pension 15 Regulation Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs and expenses related to or in support of the agency's operations. 16

Section 45. The sum of \$2,730,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission Operations Fund to the Department of Insurance for costs associated with the administration and operations of the Insurance Fraud Division of the Illinois Workers' Compensation Commission's Anti-Fraud Program.

- Section 50. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as 1 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Parity Advancement 2 Fund to the Illinois Department of Insurance for costs and 3 4 expenses related to or in support of parity compliance advocacy, consumer education, and any other initiatives that 5 6 support parity implementation and enforcement on behalf of 7 consumers.
