Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2022, as follows:

General Funds	\$650,166,400
Other State Funds	\$ 15,502,300
Federal Funds	\$ 769,000
Total	<u>\$666,437,700</u>

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**  
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The amount of \$590,654,600, or so much thereof  
6 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education  
7 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
8 Illinois to meet its operational expenses for the fiscal year  
9 ending June 30, 2023.

10 Section 10. The following named amounts, or so much thereof  
11 as may be necessary, are appropriated from the Education  
12 Assistance Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
13 Illinois for Labor and Employment Relations:

14	For degree programs .....	654,400
15	For certificate programs .....	<u>850,800</u>
16	Total	\$1,505,200

17 Section 15. The sum of \$14,803,100, or so much thereof as  
18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
19 to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
20 costs and expenses related to or in support of the Prairie

1     Research Institute, in accordance with Public Act 95-0728.

2             Section 20. The sum of \$40,380,600, or so much thereof as  
3     may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
4     to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
5     operating costs and expenses related to or in support of the  
6     University of Illinois Hospital.

7             Section 25. The sum of \$698,800, or so much thereof as may  
8     be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
9     Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
10    costs associated with the Hispanic Center for Excellence at the  
11    Chicago campus.

12            Section 30. The sum of \$276,600, or so much thereof as may  
13    be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
14    Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
15    Dixon Springs Agricultural Center.

16            Section 35. The sum of \$1,052,700, or so much thereof as  
17    may be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
18    Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
19    costs associated with the Public Policy Institute at the  
20    Chicago campus.

1           Section 40. The sum of \$294,800, or so much thereof as may  
2           be necessary, is appropriated from the Education Assistance  
3           Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
4           a grant to the College of Dentistry.

5           Section 45. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as  
6           may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund  
7           to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for  
8           costs associated with the Illinois Heart Rescue.

9           Section 50. The sum of \$5,127,300, or so much thereof as  
10          may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention Fund  
11          to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for the  
12          purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service Institute,  
13          paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the facilities  
14          and structures incident thereto, including payment to the  
15          University for personal services and related costs incurred.

16          Section 55. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as may  
17          be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and  
18          University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University  
19          of Illinois for scholarship grant awards.

20          Section 60. The sum of \$250,000 or so much thereof as may  
21          be necessary, is appropriated from the Pet Population Control

1 Fund to the University of Illinois for costs associated with  
2 pet population control at the College of Veterinary Medicine.

3 Section 65. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may  
4 be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Public Health  
5 Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and expenses  
6 related to or in support of Emergency Mosquito Abatement.

7 Section 70. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may  
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Used Tire Management  
9 Fund to the University of Illinois for costs and expenses  
10 related to or in support of mosquito research and abatement.

11 Section 75. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may  
12 be necessary, is appropriated from the Hazardous Waste Research  
13 Fund to the University of Illinois for its ordinary and  
14 contingent expenses.

15 Section 80. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may  
16 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Professions  
17 Dedicated Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of  
18 Illinois for costs associated with the development, support or  
19 administration of pharmacy practice education or training  
20 programs for the College of Medicine at Rockford.

1 Section 85. The sum of \$8,000,000 or so much thereof as may  
2 be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business  
3 on June 30, 2022, from an appropriation heretofore made for  
4 such purpose in Article 120, Section 85 of Public Act 102-0017,  
5 as amended, is reappropriated from the Coal Technology  
6 Development Assistance Fund to the University of Illinois for  
7 the Prairie Research Institute for costs associated with carbon  
8 dioxide capture technology at a coal-fired power plant, and  
9 other projects in consultation with the United States  
10 Department of Energy.

11 Section 90. The sum of \$175,000, or so much thereof as may  
12 be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business  
13 on June 30, 2022, from an appropriation heretofore made for  
14 such purpose in Article 120, Section 90 of Public Act 102-0017,  
15 as amended, is reappropriated, from the Coal Technology  
16 Development Assistance Fund to the University of Illinois for  
17 the Prairie Research Institute for costs associated with  
18 conducting the carbon capture, utilization, and storage study.

## ARTICLE 2

20 Section 5. The sum of \$769,000, or so much thereof as may  
21 be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business  
22 on June 30, 2022, from an appropriation heretofore made for

1 such purpose in Article 127, Section 215 of Public Act 102-  
2 0017, as amended, is reappropriated from the State Coronavirus  
3 Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Board of Trustees of  
4 the University of Illinois for costs associated with the water  
5 rates report under Section 115 of the University of Illinois  
6 Act for purposes permitted by Section 9901 of the American  
7 Rescue Plan Act of 2021 and related federal guidance. No  
8 contract shall be entered into or obligation incurred for water  
9 rates report from appropriations made in this section until  
10 after the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by  
11 the Governor.

12 Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1,  
13 2022.
