Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

5	Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof

- Section 5. The amount of \$55,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers'
 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois Workers'
 Compensation Commission for costs associated with the establishment of the Medical Fee Schedule and other provisions of the Workers' Compensation Act.
- Section 10. The amount of \$50,000, or so much thereof as 11 12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Workers' 13 Compensation Commission Operations Fund to Illinois Workers' 14 Compensation Commission for costs associated with 15 establishment, administration and operations of the Insurance 16 Compliance Division of the workers' compensation anti-fraud 17 administered by Illinois Workers' Compensation program 18 Commission.
- Section 99. Effective Date. This Act takes effect July 1, 20 2022.
