#### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations to the Supreme Court for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the judicial system. Effective July 1, 2022.

AN ACT concerning appropriations.

#### Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented 2 in the General Assembly: 3

4 Section 5. In addition to other sums appropriated, the sum of \$489,716,800, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is 5 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Supreme Court 6 7 for operational expenses, awards, grants, permanent improvements, and probation reimbursements for the fiscal year 8 9 ending June 30, 2023.

10 Section 10. The sum of \$29,131,200, or so much thereof as 11 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory 12 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for Mandatory Arbitration 13 Programs.

14 Section 15. The sum of \$708,800, or so much thereof as may 15 be necessary, is appropriated from the Foreign Language 16 Interpreter Fund to the Supreme Court for the Foreign Language 17 Interpreter Program.

18 Section 20. The sum of \$13,793,900, or so much thereof as 19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court 20 Special Purposes Fund to the Supreme Court for the oversight

3 Section 25. The sum of \$4,000,000, or so much thereof as 4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court 5 Federal Projects Fund to the Supreme Court for expenses 6 relating to various federal projects.

Section 30. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof may
be necessary, is appropriated from the Supreme Court Special
State Projects Fund to the Supreme Court for expenses relating
to various State projects.

Section 35. The amount of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Cannabis Expungement Fund to the Supreme Court for the distribution to clerks of the circuit court for the facilitation of petitions of expungement of minor cannabis offenses pursuant to the Cannabis Regulation and Tax Act.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Mandatory 19 Arbitration Fund to the Supreme Court for reduction of case 20 backlogs and managing increases in case filings, modernizing 21 court technology infrastructure, and Supporting Access to HB5691 -3- LRB102 26170 LNS 35776 b
